The County in accordance with its policy to offer calcium chloride as a means of soil stabilization, hereby undertakes to provide this service to the ratepayers of the County of Paintearth No. 18 under the following conditions:

- Applications for soil stabilization must be received prior to August 1st of each year.
- The applicant will be responsible to pay for the cost of the actual calcium chloride product available as determined by application metering. Billing will be submitted after the project is completed.
- The county will provide a minimum distance of 660 feet (201 meters) per site as soil stabilization treatment on the road in front of residences.
- Sites are to be staked by the Public Works Department in the presence of the applicant prior to the commencement of the application of calcium chloride.
- The County has the right to refuse the application of calcium chloride if so deemed unfeasible after the inspection of the site.
- The County will contribute the preparation of the area, additional gravel if required, the water truck and grader for the application.
- The County will maintain the road as its discretion and cost and retains the right to scarify the soil stabilization treatment in the event of excessive deterioration.
- The applicant acknowledges and agrees that the County makes no guarantee as to the life expectancy of the material process.
- Soil stabilization will be completed at the convenience of the County when materials can be transported and equipment is available to carry out the work.
- This agreement is not applicable where soil stabilization is required as a condition of a Development Permit and/or Road Use Agreement.
- This agreement cites the intention of the County to provide, and the grantor to receive a service. No other interpretation is intended or to be inferred.
