The following information is to provide a summary of Council meetings from August 2020 and upcoming activities. Further explanations or details can be obtained by contacting the County Administration Office at 403.882.3211.

**Bylaw 691-20 Emergency Management Bylaw** – Council gave first to third and final readings to Bylaw 691-20 being the Emergency Management Bylaw.

**RFD – Subdivision Plan Closure** – MOVED by Councillor Norton the County table the cancellation of Subdivision Plan 604AJ by Bylaw to a later County meeting once all the requirements to proceed have been met.

**RFD – Revisions to Policy AD 021 Schedule of Fees** – MOVED by Councillor Elliott that County Policy AD 021 be renamed the Schedule of Fees Bylaw and adoption of the amendments as presented.

**RFD – Emergency Management Policies** – MOVED by Councillor Wiart the Emergency Management Policies as renumbered, reformatted and with the applicable corrections, be adopted as presented.

**RFD – Bridge Repairs BF 13274 (SSE 29-38-14 W4)** – MOVED by Councillor Glazier the County accepts the quote for \$22,400.00 from Formula Alberta Ltd. for the bridge repairs to BF 13274 (SSE 29-38-14 W4).

**RFD – Brownfield Water System - Engineering Work** – MOVED by Councillor Blumhagen that WSP Engineering Ltd. move forward with engineering the Brownfield Water System project at an estimated cost of \$10,000.00.

**RFD – Culvert Installation on Undeveloped Road Allowance** – MOVED by Councillor Norton the County covers no cost for the replacement of the culvert on RR 135 and TWP 402 as the culvert is not located on County property.

**RFD – Culvert Installation on Field Access Road Allowance** – MOVED by Councillor Wiart the County covers no cost for the replacement of the culvert on RR 111 south of 599 on SE 35-37-11-W4 as the culvert is not located on County property.

**ASB Used Mower – Tender** - MOVED by Councillor Glazier that the tender received for the used ASB mower be accepted as the sole tender received for a value of \$5,700.00.

**Alberta Municipal Affairs – Assessment Audit** – MOVED by Councillor Wiart the correspondence received from Alberta Municipal Affairs advising that they are undertaking an Assessment Audit for the County of Paintearth be received as information and filed.
