

BYLAW NUMBER 705-22
OF THE COUNTY OF PAINTEARTH NO. 18
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BYLAW OF THE COUNTY OF PAINTEARTH NO. 18 FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING BYLAW 586-09, TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO RECREATION BOARDS AND COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS THAT ARE PROVIDING RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES TO RESIDENTS.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 63(2)(a), of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26 a municipality may provide for the repeal of a bylaw that is inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 243(1)(a), of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26 authorizes the Council of the County of Paintearth No. 18 to provide for funds for council's policies and programs as included in the operating budget.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the County of Paintearth No. 18, duly assembled, hereby enact as follows:

1. That Bylaw 586-09 be rescinded in its entirety.
