

The Owner of lands that have had brush mechanically removed along fence lines adjacent to roadsides who would like to have ongoing herbicide control of the regrowth or if the Owner wants the County to treat a prohibited noxious or noxious weed in front of his/her residence is required to complete the following form.



- 1. A site inspection will be conducted by the Director of Environmental Services or his/her designate.
- 2. A broadcast foliar application of a recommended herbicide of no more than 10 m from inside the fence along the roadside. Intersections will be controlled a minimum of 100 m back from the corner where possible.
- 3. The term of the agreement is for 3 years. If control work is required after such time a new agreement will have to be signed.
- 4. The Owner covenants and agrees with the County, on behalf of his/her their heirs, executors, administrators and successors, that he/she shall not have any claim for loss of damage caused to his/her/their property by reason of the performance of the said work, whether such loss or damage is the result of the negligence of any servant, agent, or employee of the County otherwise.
